
Nurse's Notes

Noble Crossing Elementary will be participating in the 2023 Indiana M.A.T.H. Bowl on Tuesday, April 11th at 5:30pm.

The competition will be made up of four rounds with a maximum of five different team members competing in each round. Each round shall consist of eight multiple-choice questions, varying in difficulty. The competition will be based on The National Council of Teachers of Mathematics publication Curriculum and Evaluation Standards for School Mathematics. This includes thirteen curriculum standards.

The team will meet with Mrs. Courtney and Mrs. DeSpain to practice for the competition on the following Wednesdays from 2:30-3:15 in Mrs. DeSpain's room #8. Students will need to be picked up at the school's front doors after each practice at 3:20.
